Snow & Weather Conditions

Sunday

Wet snow at the venue, cooling temps. At 1730 last night winds were building and temperatures dropped fast. Low was 16F and icing was occurring.

Overnight

Occasional snow showers. Low around 17. Wind chill values as low as zero. Breezy, with a west wind around 20 mph, with gusts as high as 34 mph. Chance of precipitation is 100%. Total nighttime snow accumulation of 2 to 4 inches possible.

Monday

Occasional snow showers, mainly before 3pm. High near 30. Wind chill values as low as zero. Breezy, with a west wind 21 to 23 mph, with gusts as high as 43 mph. Chance of precipitation is 100%. New snow accumulation of 2 to 4 inches possible

Grooming will mix natural with manmade snow. Durability will be important as old snow and dirt will mix in with new snow that fell yesterday and last night.
